Currently, **12,000+ children** are learning in safer, more engaging school environments. Supported by teachers, parents and School Management Committees, BLES goes beyond infrastructure—helping build inclusive spaces where children can learn, explore and shine.

Together with **CBRE**, we are going beyond classrooms—nurturing confidence, inspiring hope, and shaping brighter futures for thousands of children.

### Strengthening Learning and Confidence - Subhiti's Journey

Subhiti, a 15-year-old student from rural Uttar Pradesh, joined **Honda Ki Pathshala** with significant learning gaps and low confidence. Through structured academic support and mentoring, she now actively participates in class, understands core concepts in Mathematics and Science, and demonstrates steady academic progress.

## ECONOMIC WELLBEING IMPACT

Garv, a 19-year-old from South East Delhi, grew up in a rented home with his parents and siblings. With his father earning a modest income in the private sector, Garv's aspiration to build a career in hospitality sector, seemed difficult to achieve. His journey changed when a youth mobiliser introduced him to the Hospitality Training Programme at the **Centre of Excellence** in Badarpur. After completing 21st Century Skills training and a one-month hospitality course, this young man was selected for a three-month On-the-Job Training at **JW Marriott, Delhi**. He now receives a monthly stipend of ₹5,000 and is steadily moving toward a secure, dignified livelihood. This has been re-defined by him, as young Garv mentions; *"This training gave me confidence and a real chance to build my future."*
